The NAS Parakh 2024 was a large-scale National Assessment Survey conducted across India on 4th December 2024. The primary objective of this survey was to evaluate the educational proficiency of approximately 2.3 million students in Classes III, VI, and IX. This initiative formed a key part of the national-level National Achievement Survey (NAS).

Following the success of this initiative, the Government of West Bengal's Education Department launched its own State-level assessment: the State Achievement Survey (SAS). However, the results for students in the Malda district were noted to be slightly below the national average.

To proactively address and improve this situation, the District Inspector of Schools (Secondary Education), Malda, has pioneered a new programme: the District Achievement Survey (DAS).



This is an innovative initiative designed to ensure that the district's students are fully prepared before the State Achievement Survey (SAS). The main goal of this survey is to prepare students in such a way that they can participate with confidence in any future State or National-level Achievement Survey.
