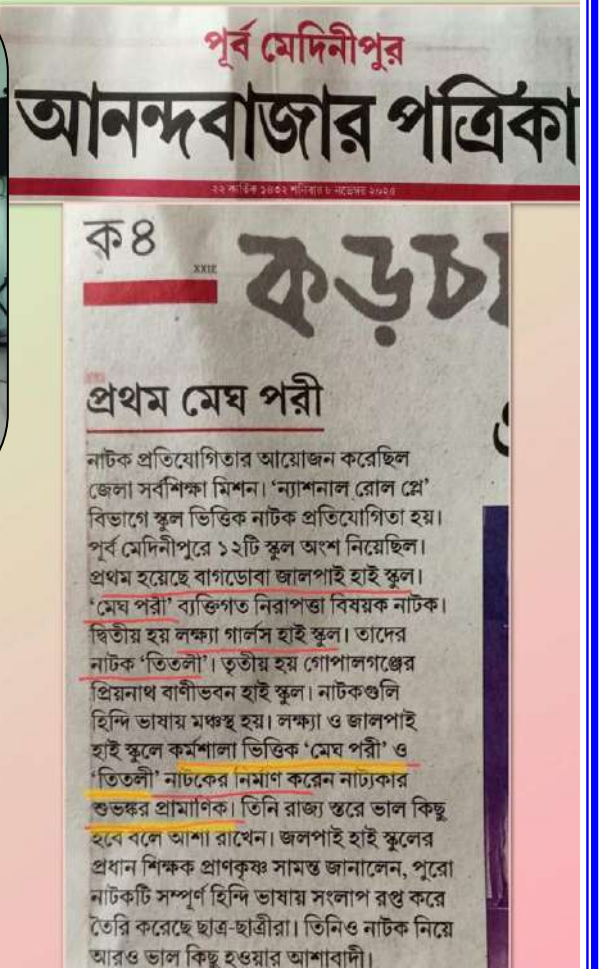


Role Play Competition : 2025

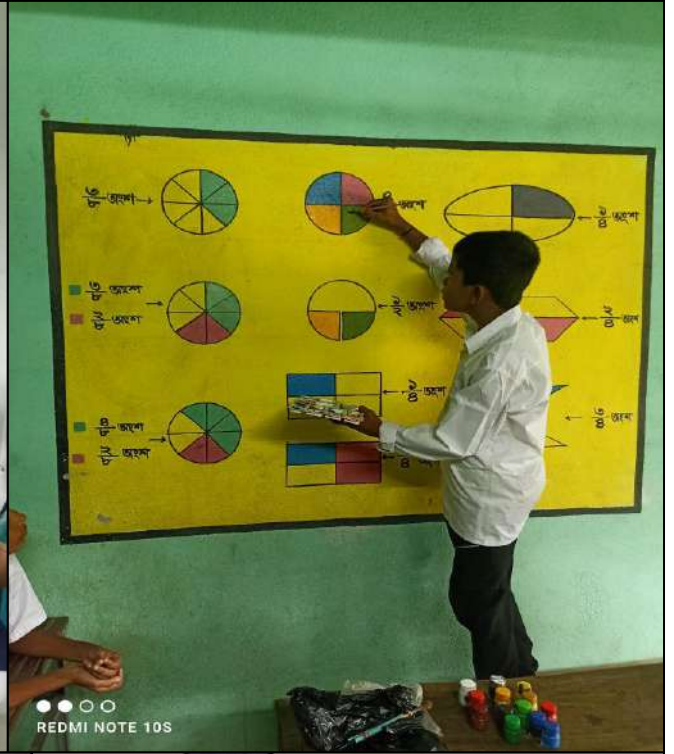

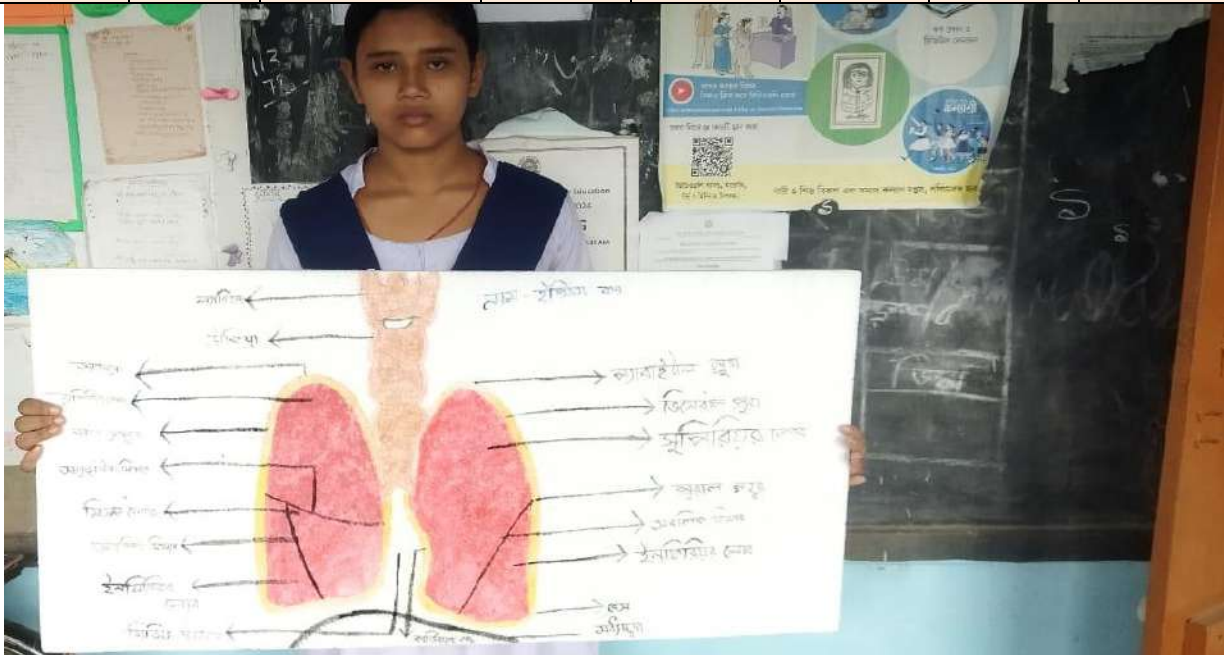

Total 72 nos. of School participated in Science Exhibition in two phases.



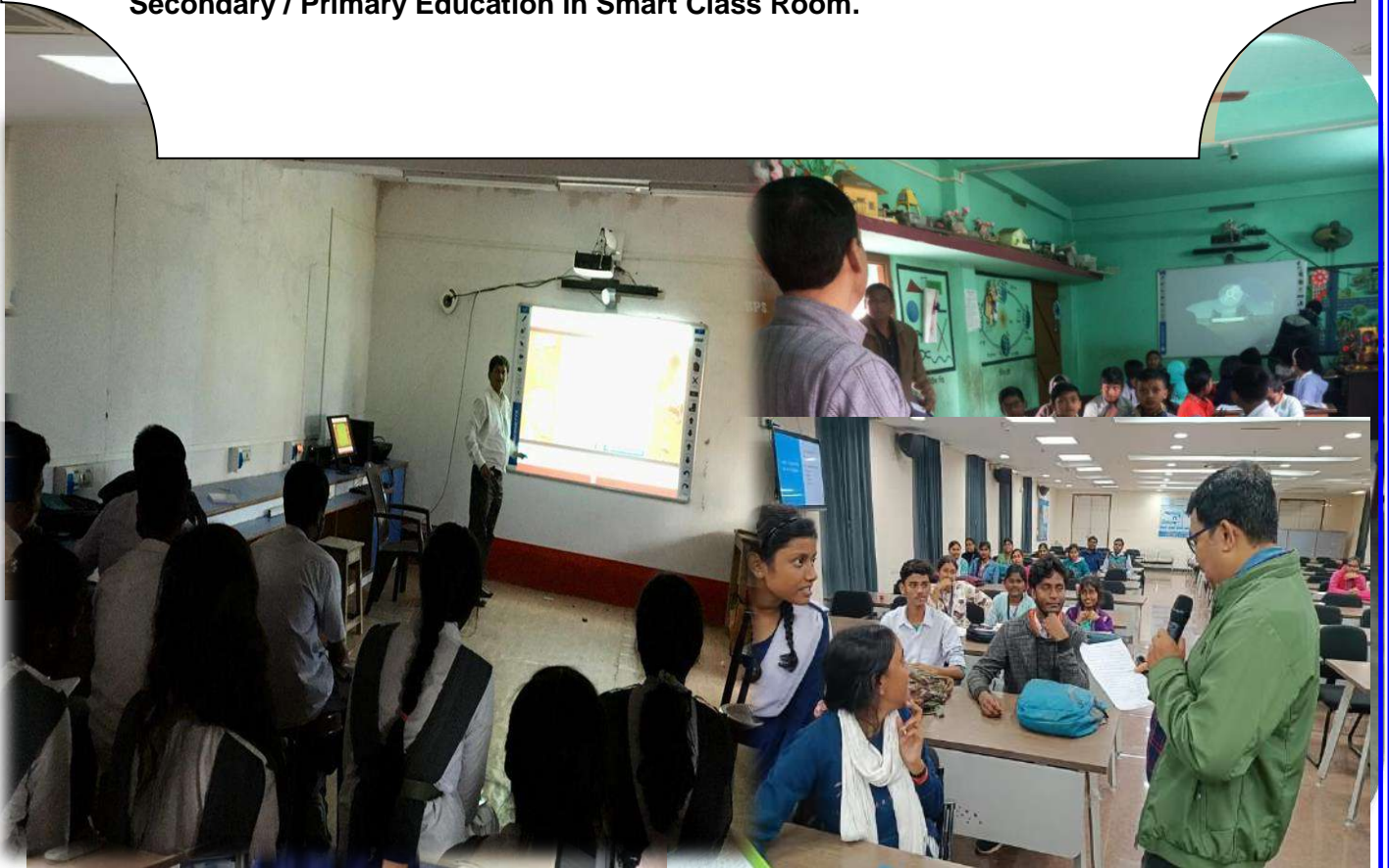
Comprehensive Career Guidance Programme for West Bengal Government Schools
