## INNOVATIVE IDEA FROM GOBINDAPUR PRY SCHOOL

To promote environmental awareness and nutrition development among students, the school distributes two fruit saplings and various vegetable seeds to each student annually, encouraging them to plant and nurture them at home. The Child Cabinet ministers conduct monthly visits to monitor the plants' progress. Students demonstrating excellent care are recognized as 'Best Tree Nurturers' and awarded annually by the school.

## Holistic Learning Experiences

The school offers nature study sessions, visits to Banks, Panchayats, and Post Offices, and excursions to historical sites and farms, moving beyond traditional classroom learning. Additionally, initiatives like 'Cinema at School', 'Nature-Based Learning', and 'Community-Based Learning' are conducted on holidays, making learning engaging, accessible, and effective for students



To encourage ICT and joyful learning, the school has implemented an audio-visual teaching method using digital calendars and digital pens. Students are engaged in group learning using digital pens and cards. Additionally, 40 digital books and pens are being used for peer learning. Around 400 slides have been prepared for teaching through projectors. Computers are being used to teach first-generation tribal students, who are learning to use mice and computers. The school has also adopted innovative methods like the Metaverse for teaching, making learning enjoyable and easy.



## Use Plastic for Gardening

The school has taken innovative initiatives to reduce plastic waste. Students collect plastic waste in "Ami Prati Na" pits at home throughout the year. The school collects 1 kg of plastic per student per year to create eco-bricks, which are used to build benches and planters. Additionally, the school creates vertical gardens by planting trees in plastic bottles and tires. To further reduce plastic use, students are making eco-friendly seed pens using paper and vegetable seeds. These initiatives promote sustainability and environmental awareness among students



Beside this school has taken initiative **to protect tree by Raksha Bandhan Utsab**. All student choose a tree to binding a Rakhi. These Rakhi is also made from natural jute.



## Regular Attendance Initiative

The school encourages mothers to ensure their children attend school daily, announcing the initiative annually. Mothers are informed that regular attendees will be rewarded. A special ceremony is held each year to honor mothers of students with the best attendance record, recognizing their efforts and motivating others to prioritize education.
